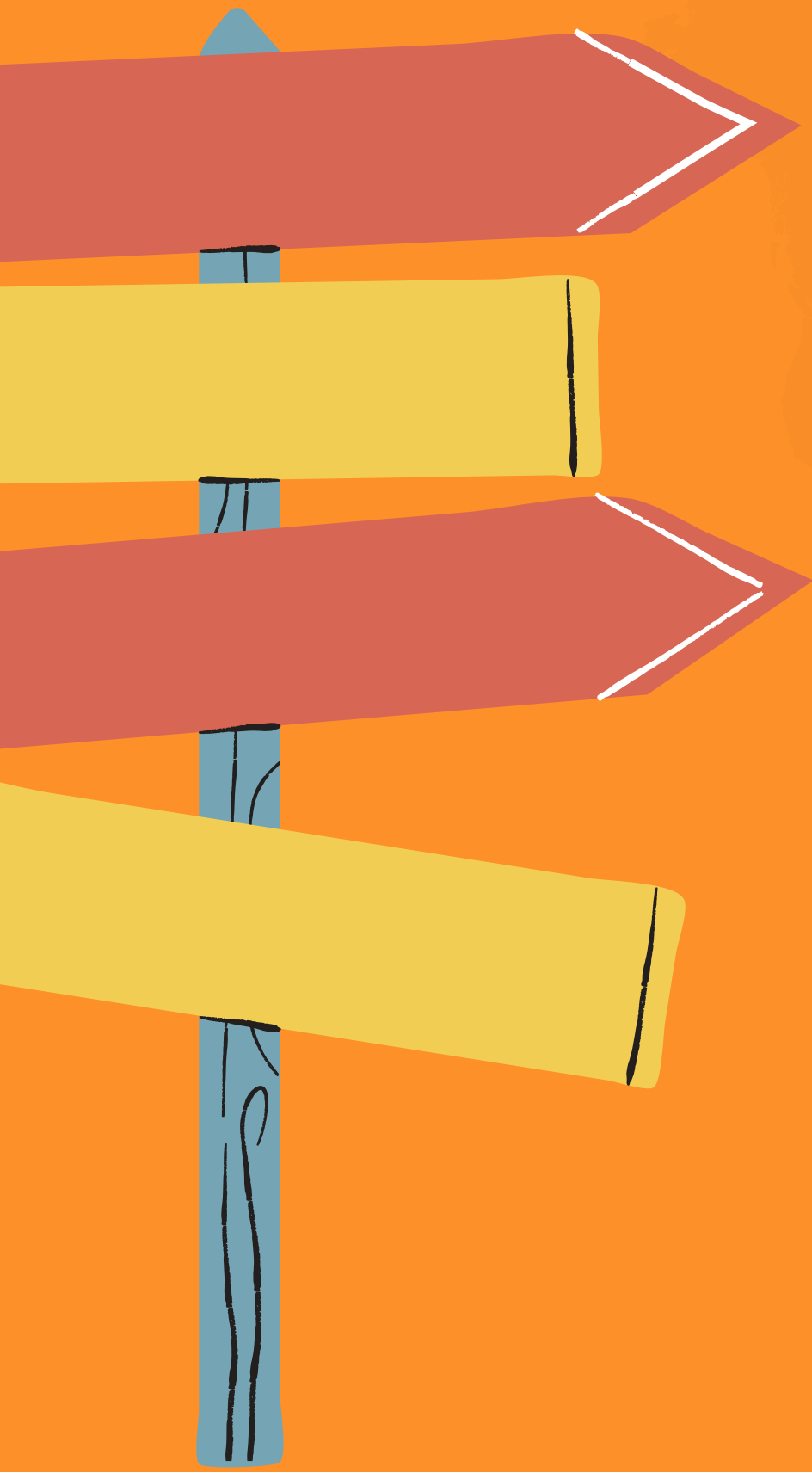




People throw tomatoes at each other!
